- Sierra Madre Police provided a popup, tables and chairs for their CP and our Net Control










SMECT - HALLOWEEN 2024


- Around 7,000 people
- No major incidents
- Incidents/found objects
 - Credit card found and turned over to police
- Lights at Baldwin and Mountain Trail had issues
- Porta potties and trash receptacles were available
 - Needed more barriers or 6 delineators & caution tape @ Mountain Trail
- Weather clear, 65 @ 1800 & 55° @ 2130
- Police, Volunteers, & Reserves
- CERT & Foothill Flyers Radio Club
- Ham Radio Support ~62 person-hours on the street
 - 19 Ham Operators from Sierra Madre with support from 6 other foothill communities
 - Hams directed visitors to crosswalks @ Baldwin & Mt Trail
- Crowds started to dissipate around 2100
- Police terminated the event around 2130 hours
